

**Memorandum of Understanding  
on Conditional Guaranteed Admission  
between  
San Mateo County Community College District  
and  
The University of Central Missouri**

In order to benefit both the University of Central Missouri (UCM) and San Mateo County Community College District (SMCCCD), which includes Cañada College, College of San Mateo & Skyline College, in the recruitment of international students, and to assist international students in their educational planning and in the completion of a baccalaureate degree, the University of Central Missouri and San Mateo County Community College District wish to enter into an agreement of conditional guaranteed admission.


Under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), the University of Central Missouri will admit qualified current SMCCCD students into the University. The University of Central Missouri agrees to define qualified SMCCCD students as those who have:

- Completed or will complete an associate's degree or 60 transferable semester units;
- Achieved a minimum cumulative college-level GPA of 2.0 in all college-level academic coursework (at all colleges attended);
- Met the University of Central Missouri English proficiency and math requirements;
- Submitted a complete transfer application and all required documents by the applicable admission deadline.

The University of Central Missouri and SMCCCD agree that:

- SMCCCD will inform prospective international students of this 2 + 2 partnership.
- Both institutions will advertise this 2 + 2 partnership on their website.
- SMCCCD will mail the University of Central Missouri a "Conditional Letter of Admission" to all international students who select the University of Central Missouri.
- SMCCCD will provide the University of Central Missouri with the contact information of students who chose the University of Central Missouri guaranteed conditional admission.
- The University of Central Missouri will offer the UCM Global Partnership Non-Resident Scholarship to students who meet the following criteria.
  - Student transfers from an institution that UCM has an active partnership agreement with.
  - Student must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or higher.
  - Students must maintain a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or better throughout the program.

This MOU will be valid when it is signed by both the University of Central Missouri Representative and the SMCCCD Representative.
