Course options include

- Advanced Practicum (6 credits)

Students work independently to complete the requirements for their EdS degree. All courses for the EdS at UCM can be completed online.

- Educational Entrepreneurism
- Leadership & Ethics in a Diverse Society
- Institutional Research, Assessment, & Accreditation

Dissertation Courses (12 credits)

Four courses in the second year of the program.

Students will work together in a cohort model over two years (Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters) to complete the degree. Courses will be offered via distance delivery or Internet communication.
